Düsseldorf, August 25, 2025 – agriBIOME, the microbiome-powered edtech startup redefining soil and livestock health, has successfully closed its first financing round, securing a bridge investment to accelerate product development, commercial activities and international expansion.

The round follows a rapid growth trajectory:

Founded in January 2025, agriBIOME officially launched operational business in June and has already gained traction across both European and U.S. markets. Earlier this year the company has also been already part of the German Accelerator U.S. Climate Tech cohort funded by the German Ministry of Economic Affairs.

The funding includes support from the NRW.Bank.

“This is more than a financing milestone. It’s proof that our belief in biology-based agriculture is shared by both farmers and institutions,” said Claus-A. Boche, co-founder and Managing Director of agriBIOME. “But we’re also incredibly proud to have paying customers on board already and a U.S. entity up and running.”

The investment will be used to:

Expand agriBIOME’s microbiome-based feed and soil health portfolio, scale operations and advance R&D and trials in crop and livestock systems.
